COURSE: Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Course (Fall "12")

Course Description: The Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Program is the basis for all higher levels of certification in Virginia. This program provides general instruction in all areas of human body systems and initial care of a wide range of medical conditions. Class Hours: 111 hours of classroom and skills instruction plus 10 hours of clinical observation in a pre-hospital setting.

CPR IS A PRE-REQUISITE FOR THIS COURSE. ALL PARTICIPANTS IN THIS COURSE MUST ATTEND THE CPR COURSE ON 9/8/2012.
