Should a true act of violence incident occur in Fauquier County the NOVA Joint Action Guide for High Threat Environments shall be followed. It is imperative to follow these guidelines in order to minimize confusion between Fauquier County units and outside Mutual Aid resources. Copies of the guide are available in Target Solutions and from the administrative office on request.

To further clarify initial incident command procedures, a local addendum is being added as stated below.

The following actions shall be completed by the Incident Commander.

- *Fire and Rescue will establish Initial Incident Command and monitor Law Enforcement unit locations and radio traffic on Fire and Rescue Channel 11 O until the arrival of a LE Command Officer so Unified Command can be established.*
- *Monitor the appropriate Law Enforcement Channel (15) for situational awareness and incident updates.*
