The Fauquier County Department of Fire and Rescue has recently been requested to assist with the staffing and response of Remington Volunteer Fire and Rescue Department's "Truck 2". The leadership of both organizations have met and agreed that in an effort to supply the citizens of Fauquier County with the highest level of service possible, it would be in the best interest of both parties to work in conjunction to ensure the response capabilities of Truck 2 were maximized.

To establish a baseline knowledge level to build skills from, all members are required to have completed the Virginia Department of Fire Programs Introduction to Technical Rescue Module 1 prior to September 13, 2017. Once logged in, search for VDFP ITR. The course should take 1 to 1.5 hours to complete.
