V.E.I.S, Vent, Enter, Isolate, Search is a tactic widely becoming an option for crews working on the fire ground when fire conditions present so as to make alternative access a must when searching for viable victims. During our March monthly in-service training, Lt. Twomey and Technician Wilson will discuss the methodology behind this tactic and how it can be useful in our current system of fire response.

The training evolutions will be delivered in 90 minute time blocks and allow units travel time to and from their respective first due areas. Full Personal Protective Clothing is required for this training evolution.

It is imperative that units arrive on time for their allotted evolutions and return immediately following completion in an effort to facilitate next arriving and ensure adequate area coverage. Units listed for relocations must promptly report to destination stations at the times indicated.

In an effort to complete this training with personnel and maintain Engine 1105 coverage, overtime is authorized for personnel who will be required to staff from 0600 to approximately 1200 hours on the day following their normally scheduled work shift. Engine 1105 crews attending training may utilize the pick-up assigned to Station 5 for transport to and from the exercise.
