

Minimum Staffing	201	Revised

Please note the effective date of April 16, 2018 for this revision. Below are the highlights of the changes that concern how units mark responding on the radio. Staffing numbers are no longer required to be announced.

***V. Replacement of Understaffed Units***

- A. Any properly staffed units, as defined in section III, making a response to mitigate a fire or EMS emergency incident will mark responding on the radio by stating their unit identifier is responding (e.g. “Engine 22 responding”).***
- B. Any unit responding that does not meet minimum staffing as defined in section III will mark responding on the radio by stating their unit identifier is responding understaffed (e.g. “Engine 22 responding understaffed”).***
- C. Any unit responding to an event type listed in section V.F. and is understaffed shall immediately request to be replaced with the next due unit in an effort to secure the minimum staffing standard set forth above.***
