Effective immediately each ambulance will be allowed to carry 1 (one) Narc Pack. At NO time shall there be more than one Narc Pack per unit unless authorized by the on duty Battalion Chief.

In the past, if a Medic unit went out of service, it was acceptable to place the second Narc Pack in the safe on the in-service medic unit. This is no longer an acceptable action.

If a medic unit goes out of service, the Narc Pack will need to be returned to the pharmacy for proper storage. The responsibility for returning the Narc Pack is assigned to the ALS provider removing the Narc Pack from the unit. The on duty Battalion Chief shall be immediately notified if assistance is required with this process. Alternative plans are being evaluated and additional information will be shared when available.
