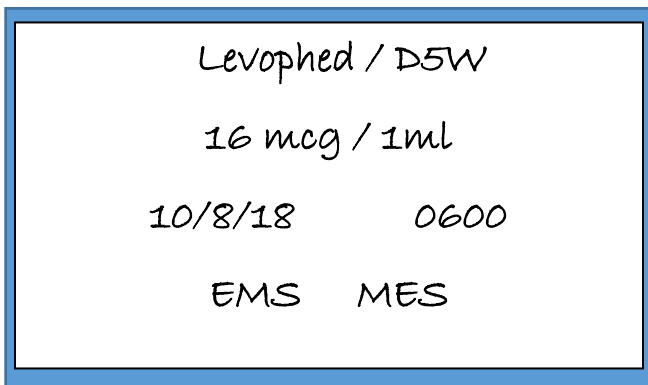
Blank medication labels will be placed on all transport units. A photo of the rolls is located below. These labels shall be used to properly mark medication bags that have been prepared in the field.

The label shall include:

- Drug / What solution (D5W or NSS)
- Concentration
- Date / Time
- EMS / Initials of who prepared

The medication labels will be available in our supply cabinet at the ER. All field prepared medications must have a label to avoid improper dosing of a patient in the event of transfer of care either in field (to a helicopter or other unit) or transfer of care in hospital.
