Each quarter, a general order will be issued directing identified personnel <u>to call the wellness center</u> to schedule a physical appointment. Personnel should schedule an appointment date in their birth month unless extenuating circumstances exist. Personnel not able to schedule in their birth month shall contact Battalion Chief Johnson with the circumstances. Appointments shall be made for off-duty days and overtime is authorized.

The Wellness Center staff will facilitate the necessary paper work and advise you of any requirements for your exam(s). <u>Please make sure to complete any paper work prior to your arrival.</u> The Wellness Center staff will also work with Battalion Chief Johnson to monitor compliance with the scheduling general orders.

All personnel shall take their issued SCBA face piece to the appointment. N95 masks will be provided at the exam. The intent is that personnel will receive a new N95 mask to carry as a personal issue N95 mask.
