Class size is limited to 25.

All certified EMS personnel will be required to complete the Target Solutions Training on the new protocols prior to coming to a protocol class. Failure to complete the Target Solutions prior to the in-person session will result in admission to the session being denied. All system members who are EMS certified and wish to be considered released providers within Fauquier County are required to complete this training. **Failure to complete the 2022 Protocols Update, by June 30, will result in the suspension of the provider's authorization to practice until such time as they complete the protocol update.**
