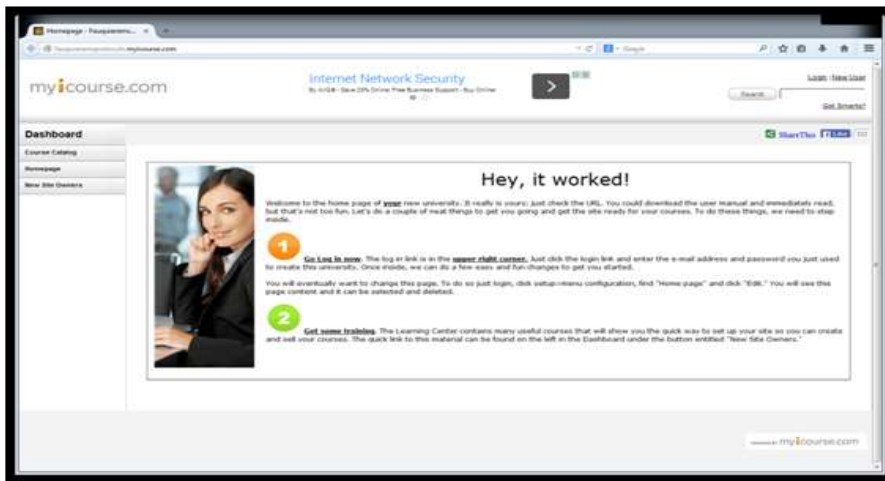

### Step One:

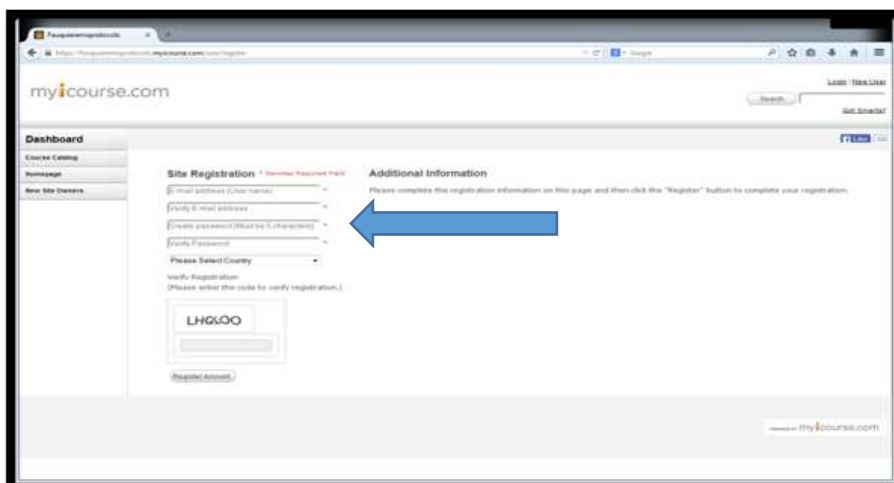
Follow this link <http://fauquieremsprotocols.myicourse.com/>

Once there, click **NEW USER** at the top right corner of the page. If you are an existing user, you should use your existing information.



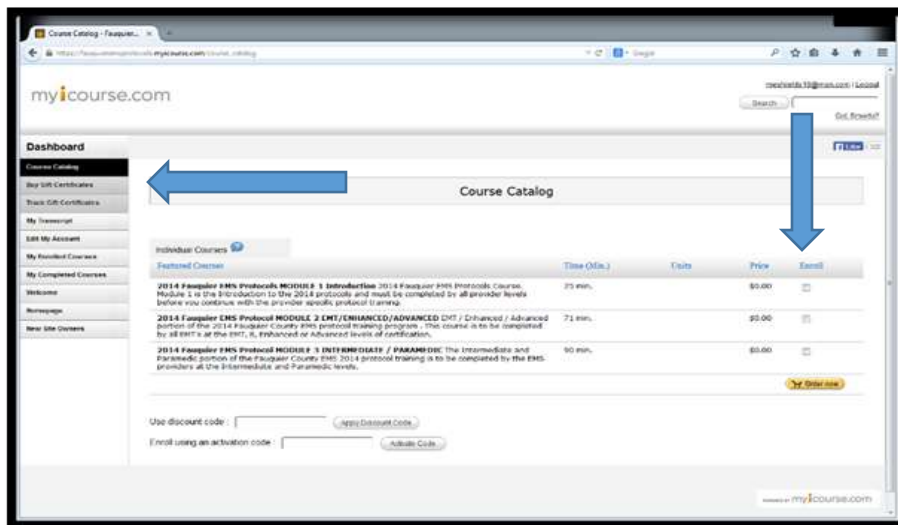
### Step two:

Step Three:

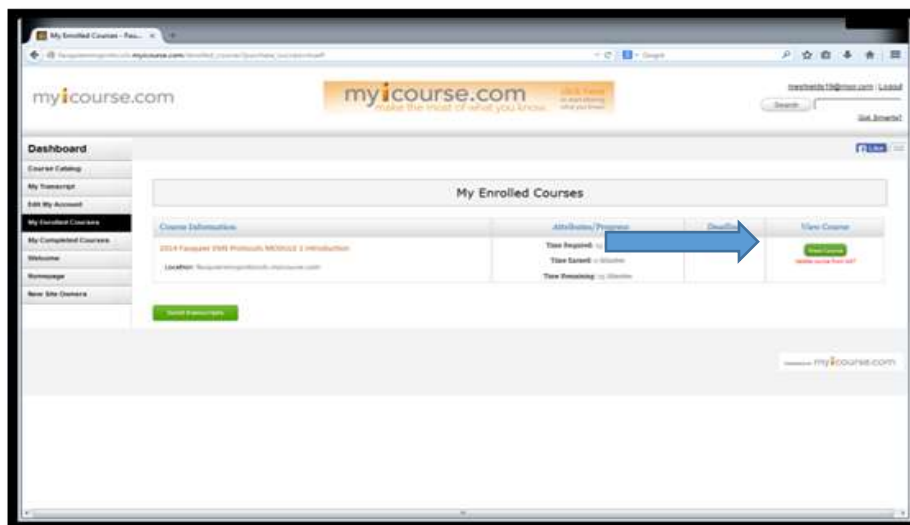

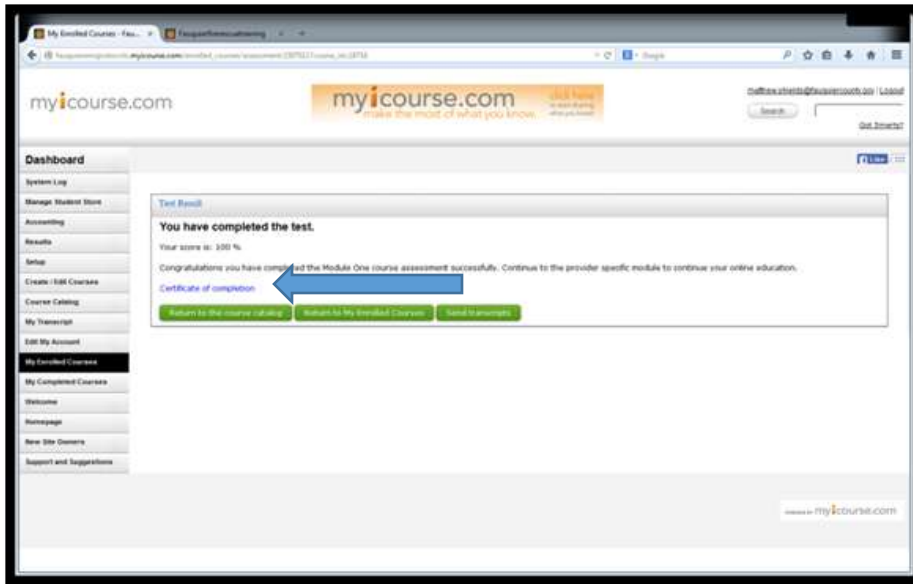
**Check the enroll box** on module/course - then click **Order Now.**
