We have now completed a patient data exchange agreement between DFREM and Inova. With this data exchange our ePCRs will automatically import into Inova's EPIC medical record system and eventually we will be able to receive patient outcome data back from them.

In order for the transfer to sync successfully, our ePCRs will require two additional fields to be documented:

1. Hospital Medical Record Number (MRN)
2. Encounter Number

If you transport to Inova Fairfax or you transfer care to a helicopter who transports to Inova Fairfax, you will need to contact the Inova Communication Center at (703) 776-2072. The Communications Specialist should be able to provide you with this information and if not, they should be able to put you in contact with registration.

Please do not enter these numbers until your report is complete. The system will run the validity rules when you sync the chart or when you save the chart after it is on the server. If the validity rules are met (see below for the rules), then the chart will export into Inova's EPIC medical record system. This transfer will only occur once, so it is imperative that your chart is complete prior to entering the Hospital MRN and Encounter number.

### Required Data for ImageTrend to Export

1. Patient's First and Last Name
2. Patient's Gender
3. Patient's Date of Birth
4. *Hospital MRN #*
5. *Encounter Number*
6. Destination Name must be one of the following : Inova Fairfax Hospital • Non-Hospital (Used when patient care is transferred outside of the ER – such as medevac transport)

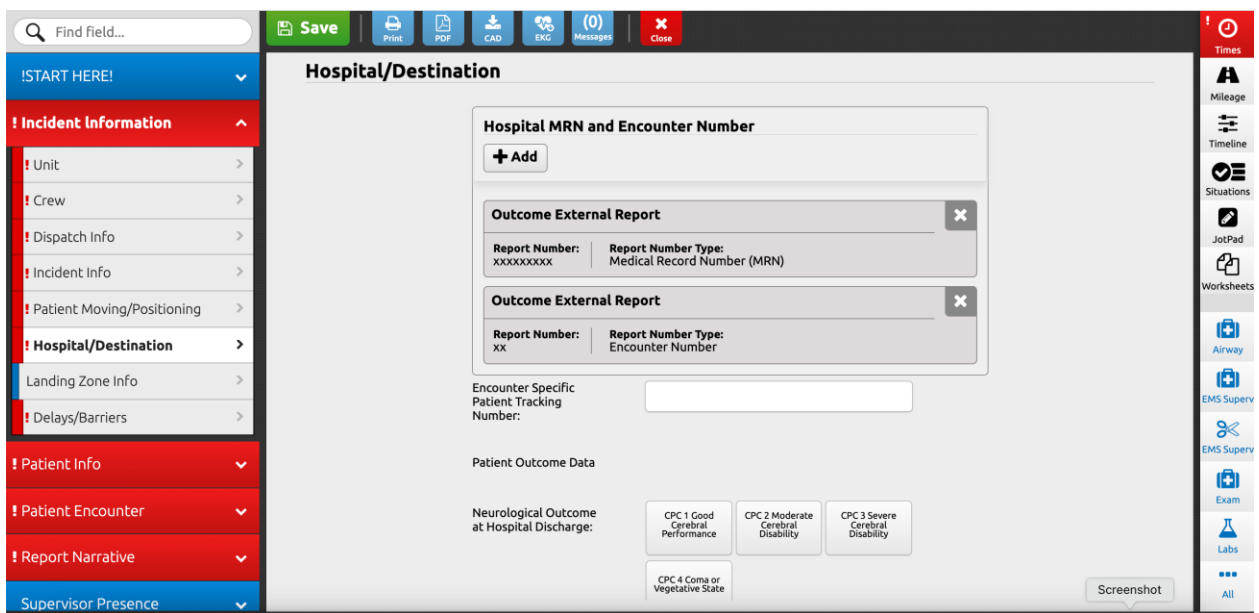
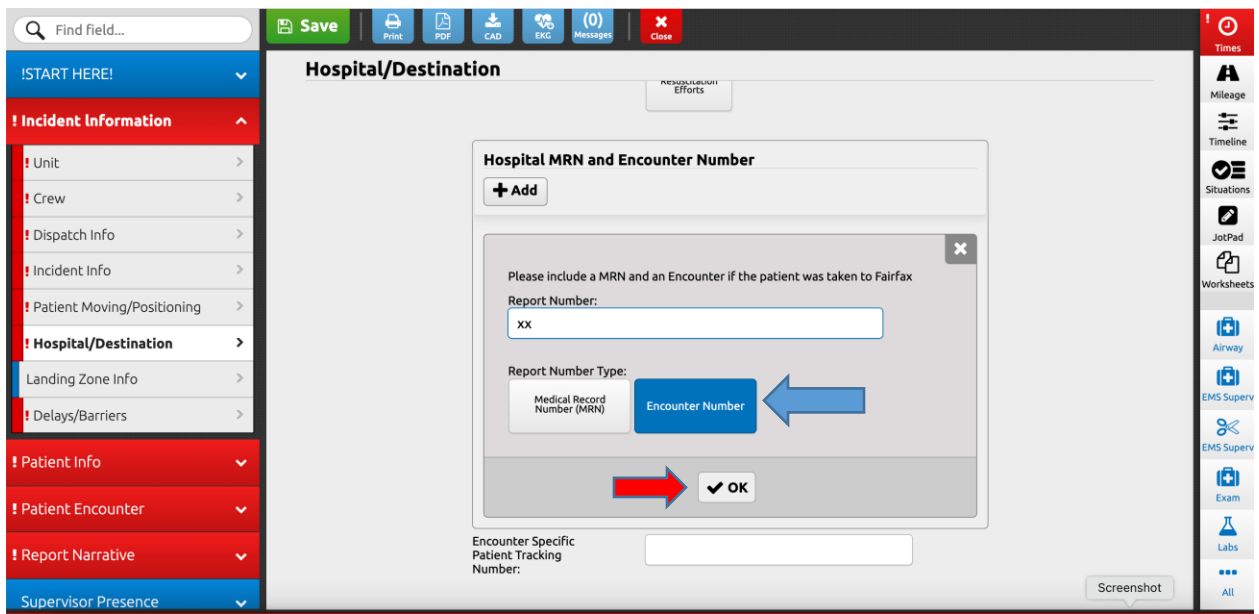
