## High Acuity EMS After Action Review

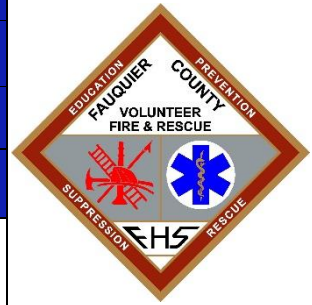

The High Acuity EMS Incident Assessment Form, FRF 960, is to provide an approved format to communicate the outcome, positive or negative, for high acuity EMS incidents.

FRF 960 will serve as a training tool for the entire department. It will explain high acuity ems incidents and rationale for treatment or withholding of treatment and the outcome for the patient.

A Battalion Chief or EMS Supervisor may request any provider to complete a High Acuity EMS After Action Review Form. This form will not replace any documentation for quality assurance or quality improvement and is only to be used for training purposes. It shall not replace press releases or other means of public information.

This is for **internal use only**. The individual completing the form shall be conscious of the requirement to withhold any information protected by HIPAA privacy legislation.

FRF 960 can be found in SharePoint under DFREM Forms, Training. All completed forms will be kept in a repository in SharePoint titled High Acuity EMS After Action Review.
