Over the next few weeks, County IT will be coming out to the stations to complete a physical inventory of the routers installed in all response vehicles. In most cases this should be a simple verification of information already available, but there are some discrepancies that need to be resolved.

Corey Jarvis at IT will be overseeing this effort with support from Bruce Quinn. The schedule proposed is to complete the stations on the same day per battalion (central, north, south), with any follow-up as needed. They would like to start next week.

It may be necessary to move equipment out of the station to isolate it from other signals so that they can identify the wi-fi on the router installed on the vehicle. They hope to clearly document where the routers are installed but will not be looking to pull down headliners, etc. We need to make a best effort to have someone available at the stations to support this effort who can both get them access into the bays and move rigs if needed. Please also make sure that vehicles which may not normally be housed are available if possible.
