NREMT Recertification Reminder

As a reminder, providers who have a NREMT expiration of 3/31/2024, if you are going to recertify you have to logon to the NREMT website and submit your Continuing Education. There are two paths to doing this.

- 1. Path 1** – Your VA OEMS CE cycle and NREMT CE cycle are in synch. This means that you recertify your Virginia certification every two years with your NREMT certification.

Under this path, you can follow the [VA OEMS Quick Guide to Completing National Registry Recertification Application - March 2024 Cycle](#). This process is quick and easy and requires you to only enter three courses matching the total number of hours for NCCR, LCCR and ICCR.

- 2. Path 2** – Your certification cycles are not in synch. This would occur where you have recertified Virginia not in line with NREMT. In this case, you will know because you have CE hours on your Virginia CE report that are OUTSIDE the range of your NREMT certification. CE hours not taken within the certification window are no eligible to be used. Or you recertified mid cycle with NREMT.

Under this path you will have to enter each class individually. By looking at your CE report you will have all the information needed to enter the hours into NREMT. If you need to look at previous hours, you can easily do so by accessing you “Active/Inactive CE Report” on the VA OEMS Portal. To access this:

Navigate to the VA OEMS Portal Website and login, go to “My Tests & Eligibility”, then navigate to “Active/Inactive CE Report”. You will need to enter the date range that is for your NREMT certification.

Once you have submitted your recertification application, you DO NOT need to make any notification to either Lt. Coleman or BC Cluff. Recertification applications will be processed on the following dates:

March 1st, 7th, 13th, 22nd, 28th, 31st.
