In an effort to protect the department's workforce from environmental contaminants such as poisons oak, sumac, and ivy, IvyX cleansing wipes will now be supplied as a component of the personal infection control (PIC) kits. Please read the following information about the use and safety of this product.

All on-duty exposures should be reported as such; however, this product will prevent most of our personnel from being affected by common poisonous plant oil exposures when used appropriately. Each member will be issued five cleansing wipes to be placed in their individual PIC kits. Additionally, each station will be given one additional box for resupply. Personnel can order additional or replacement wipes through Mrs. Kidd or the DFREM online store. This item will be included in newly issued PIC kits effective immediately.
