



FAUQUIER COUNTY FIRE, RESCUE & EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT TRAINING ADVISORY

COURSE: Swiftwater Boat Operation and Rescue

Course Description: includes both classroom and practical hands-on training in boat selection, recommended equipment, boat-handling, moving-water tactics, and boat-rescue techniques. This course meets NFPA 1670 technician level guidelines. [Click for Course Video](#)

Special Note: Students enrolled in swift water programs must be prepared to engage in strenuous activities in extreme weather and water conditions. If a student has a known medical condition that could foreseeably jeopardize his/her safety during participation or be aggravated by participation, the student should not participate.

The program is designed to train fire, rescue, police, park and other emergency services personnel. **The minimum age for attending any water rescue course is 18 years-of-age.**

Prerequisites which are required prior to the first day of class:

- **Swiftwater Technician** - only a PA WRER or Rescue 3 Technician level course will be accepted.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT: A U.S. Coast Guard approved (type V) personal flotation device (PFD), water rescue helmet, gloves, shoes, throw bag, dry suit, and appropriate clothing for water and weather conditions

Saturday, August 4th 2018, at 0800hrs
Sunday, August 5th, at 0900hrs

LOCATION: Warrenton Fire Station 1 (Downstairs Training Room)
COURSE COST: \$200.00 for all students
