An addendum to the Fauquier County Medical Treatment Guidelines - 2020 "Critical Care Protocols/Procedures for EMS Supervisors has been updated to reflect the following protocol changes.

- Updated Table of Contents - Critical Care Procedures/Protocols
- CC4 Hypotension/Shock
 - Cardiogenic shock -addition of Epinephrine Infusion and Dopamine Infusion
 - Sepsis/Neurogenic Shock - addition of Epinephrine Infusion
 - Anaphylactic Shock - addition of Epinephrine Infusion
 - Hemorrhagic – No refers to Trauma Management Protocol
- CC6 OB/GYN Emergencies
 - Terbutaline added to Pre-Term labor between 24-34 weeks
 - Labetalol added to Preeclampsia arm of the protocol
 - Oxytocin dosing changed to 10 units IV under Postpartum arm of the protocol
- Added new protocol - CC8 Post Resuscitation Care
- CC13 Trauma Management
 - Added blood transfusion for hemorrhagic shock
- Added new protocol CC13A – Blood Administration
- Updated Medication Reference numbering
- Added/changed numbering - Medication Reference CC26 Labetalol
- Changed dosing/numbering - Medication Reference CC30 Pitocin
- Changed dosing/numbering - Medication Reference CC32 Terbutaline
- Added CC33 Effective Date page
