


In effort to accurately represent modern staffing levels and corresponding unit identification. We will no longer be utilizing the Shock Trauma nomenclature (SK1108).

Starting on October 3, 2022, all AEMT (Advanced) staffed ambulances will verbalize Advanced Ambulance terminology in and out of Fauquier County.
