During the month of February, Fauquier County Fire and Rescue will be conducting PALS recertification for ALS providers. This course will be conducted in 6-hour session and is mandatory for all ALS providers. Please see the schedule below for the date you are assigned. Overtime is authorized. Each class will start at 0730.

For Volunteer system members who are ALS certified, there is an additional weekend date open for registration, Saturday February 18, 2023. The Saturday class will start at 0800. This will also serve as an alternate day for department personnel. Volunteer personnel can register for the class at fauquierfirerescue.org. If volunteer personnel are wishing to attend one of the weekday classes, please contact Lt. Jordan Coleman at Jordan.Coleman@fauquiercounty.gov. Class size is limited to 16. Registration will close two weeks prior to each class.

Personnel should report to the Warrenton Armory EMS Simulation Lab for the class. If you have a conflict with your scheduled date, please send notice to Lt. Jordan Coleman and your respective Battalion Chief requesting an alternate date. Deadline for schedule change requests will be due no later than COB on **December 27, 2022**.
