The following protocols have been revised as indicated:

- OP 320.09 Fever – added wording for BLS dosage of Acetaminophen and Ibuprofen in adults
- OP 320.30 Multi-system Trauma – revised dosing for TXA
- OP 320.34 Allergic Reaction-Anaphylaxis (Pediatric) – added PO dosing for diphenhydramine
- OP 320.49 Respiratory Distress (Adult) – revised Magnesium infusion to over 10 minutes
- OP 320.51 Sedation – added IM administration route utilizing Ketamine
- OP 340.02 albuterol (Proventil) – added crush syndrome dosing
- OP 340.06 atropine sulfate (Atropine) – corrected pediatric bradycardia dosing
- OP 340.11 diphenhydramine (Benadryl) – added PO dosing for diphenhydramine
- OP 340.12 epinephrine (Adrenalin) – corrected infusion concentration
- OP 340.22 ketamine (Ketanest) – added IM route of administration
- OP 340.26 magnesium sulfate– corrected IV infusion administration time and pediatric dosing in Torsades de pointes
- OP 340.29 midazolam (Versed) – added hypotension as an adverse reaction
- OP 340.38 sodium bicarbonate – eliminated crush syndrome reference
- OP 340.40 tranexamic acid (Cyklokapron) – added dosing change to support OP 320.30
- OP 370.08 23.4% Saline – added reference
- OP 380.02 EMS Resources – eliminated unnecessary second page
