Fauquier County Fire and Rescue will be continuing to assist community partners in hosting several COVID-19 vaccination clinics, as well as creating a mobile clinic for our hard to reach community members. In preparation for this collaborative project, we are now in need of AEMTs, EMT-Intermediates and Paramedics to complete the online training that is outlined below. Personnel that are interested should complete this training as soon as possible as we will be assisting vaccinating in the immediate future.
