


The new Fauquier County Cancer Center, located at 210 West Shirley Ave, provides outpatient services for oncology, infusion therapy, hematology, and urology. Previously, these services were offered in the hospital, eliminating the needs for EMS when a patient experienced an emergency. The increased risk of anaphylactic/adverse reactions from treatments will more than likely require the need of EMS now that they have moved out of the main hospital facility. They offer services during normal business hours, Monday through Friday.





The building is 24,136 sq. feet, with the main entrance off of West Shirley Ave. This is the most ideal entrance for EMS calls, it is also where the supra box is located, which contains 3 key cards and a master key to the facility.



The back of the facility is for future growth and is unoccupied. There is an external door on both the Bravo and Delta sides of the facility, but require a key card for access. There is roof access wall ladder from the first door on the right in the hallway past at atrium. All utilities are located on the Charlie/Delta corner, as is the sprinkler room, and the electrical/mechanical room.




Charlie Delta Corner with gas shut off behind the construction barrels, electrical panel on side delta, and generator to the left.




Gas meter base and shut off, exterior side Charlie
