The National Registry of EMTs has opened their 2023 recertification cycle. This cycle is open for those persons who hold a NREMT card that is set to expire on March 31, 2023. The Virginia Office of EMS has released their Quick Guide to Completing National Registry Recertification for the March 2023 Cycle. Department personnel wishing to recertify their NREMT status should refer to this guide for directions on how to properly submit their Virginia Hours that apply to this cycle.

Lt. Coleman will be hosting virtual sessions that cover a step by step process on how to do this. These sessions will be in the morning following the conference call and will cover how to add hours to the NREMT profile.
