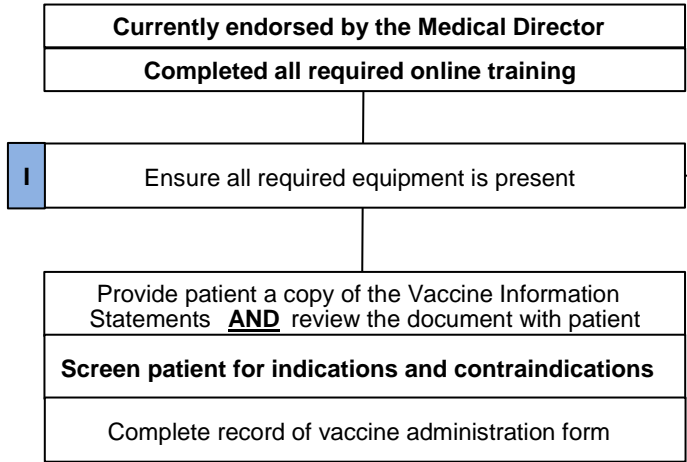
II. PROCEDURE

The Fauquier County Department of Fire, Rescue, and Emergency Management hereby adopts the Special Protocol – Pandemic Vaccination.

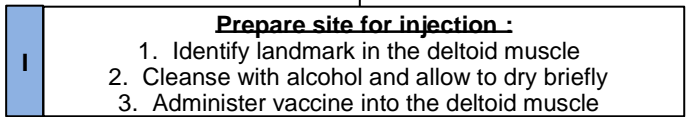
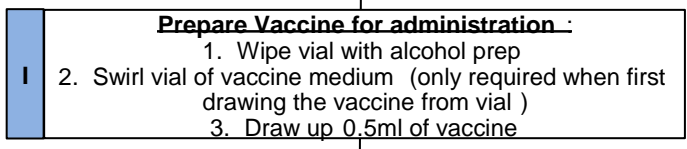
All members in the Fauquier County Fire and Rescue System shall adhere to the procedures and guidelines outlined within Special Protocol – Pandemic Vaccination.

Provider Administered Immunizations – MODERNA COVID -19

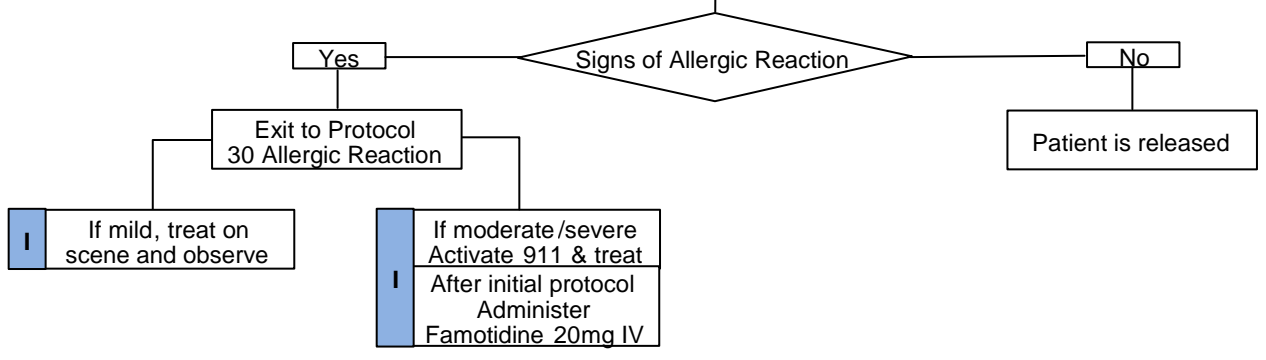
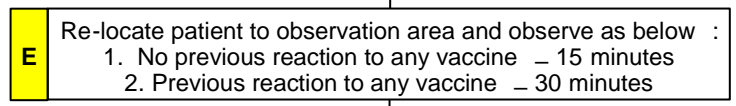
NOTE:

- REQUIRED EQUIPMENT**
1. Epinephrine 1:1000
 2. Methylprednisolone
 3. Diphenhydramine
 4. Famotidine
 5. Oxygen and delivery equipment
 6. Intubation Kit
 7. IV kit present
 8. Assorted syringes /needles
 9. IV Fluids and setup
