This safety bulletin is a reminder to all members that hot weather is upon us and we must protect against the environmental demands of this profession. Outlined below are some of the health and safety materials you have and should be using when applicable. This safety is a reminder to check those items and order replacements if needed. We understand that these items may be overlooked during the cold winter months when they are less likely to be used.

### 1. Ivy X wipes.

Apply after coming into contact with poisonous plants and this product will provides an invisible barrier to help protect exposed skin to poisonous plants. Non-greasy, water and sweat resistant and dries quickly.



### 2. Sun x 30 sunscreen lotion.

This product helps prevent sunburn and skin cancer caused by the harmful effects of the sun. With UVB and UVA protection this product packaged in a single use packet is essential for protection all year but especially during the hot summer months.
