## TRAINING ADVISORY

**COURSE: EMT-ADVANCED**

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** The primary focus of the EMT-Advanced is to provide basic and limited advanced emergency medical care and transportation for critical and emergency patients who access the emergency medical system. Advanced Emergency Medical Technicians function as part of a comprehensive EMS response, under medical oversight. Advanced Emergency Medical Technicians perform interventions with the basic and advanced equipment typically found on an ambulance. Virginia EMS Education Standards for the AEMT is designed to educate the technician in the following areas of pre-hospital care: preparatory skills, airway management and ventilation, patient assessment, trauma, medical, special considerations and assessment based management. A minimum of 48 hours are devoted to clinical rotations in the Emergency Department and in the field. For Virginia Trained AEMT, successful certification at the National Registry AEMT level will automatically lead to a Virginia AEMT certification.

PRE-TEST to be given April 27<sup>th</sup> – Please allow 90 minutes for TEST

- Must be at least 18 years of age with high school diploma or GED
- Must hold current state EMT for 1 year and NLS Provider (NPR) certification from approved course.
- MUST present copy of immunization record
- Must pass PRE-TEST with Score of 85% or better
- Must pass background and drug tests through [www.castlebranch.com](http://www.castlebranch.com) at a cost of \$133.00. Must be completed no earlier than 30 days before the class start date
- Physical Interview required with Advisory committee
- Letter of recommendation from company officer

**DATES/TIMES:** Very aggressive schedule beginning May 2019 and ending August 2019 – Psychomotor and National Registry Testing
